The regular monthly board meeting was opened at 6:30 PM by Roland Martin, Board President.

Roland Martin asked the Board Members if there were any comments, questions, or corrections regarding the Minutes of April 12th, 2022, Regular Meeting of the Board Minutes. Keith Kallstrom moved, and Kevin Askeland second the motion to accept financials as presented in the Consent Agenda. Motion passed.

Accounts Payable as of April 30th, 2022: David Abbott introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption: **RESOLUTION 13-2022. BE IT RESOLVED**, that, the Accounts Payable statement of Operations & Maintenance bills in the amount of Forty-Two Thousand Nine Hundred Four Dollars and Thirty-Nine Cents (\$42,904.39), Construction bills in the amount of Three Hundred Sixty Dollars and No Cents (\$360.00), and Equipment in the amount of Twenty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Eighty Dollars and Twenty-Four Cents (\$26,580.24) to be paid. Whereupon the motion or adoption of the foregoing resolution was seconded by Keith Kallstrrom; and upon vote being taken thereon, the vote in favor of was unanimous.

BE IT RESOLVED, that, the Sun Prairie Village County Water and Sewer District receive from TSEP Nineteen Thousand Six Hundred Forty Dollars and Three Cents (\$19,640.03), to make payment towards Morrison Maierle Invoice #000224630 dated 4/19/2022 in the amount of Twenty-Six Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty-Eight Dollars and Fifty-Three Cents (\$26,738.53). Whereupon the motion or adoption of the foregoing resolution was seconded by Keith Kallstrom; and upon vote being taken thereon, the vote in favor of was unanimous. Kevin Askeland introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption: RESOLUTION 15-2022. BE IT RESOLVED, that, the Sun Prairie Village County Water and Sewer District receive from the State of Montana DNRC ARPA Grant Four Hundred Forty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars and Ninety-Five Cents (\$446,435.95), to make payment to Central Excavation Contractor's Application for Payment No. 2 and Gross Receipts Tax to MT Dept of Revenue. Whereupon the motion or adoption of the foregoing resolution was seconded by Keith Kallstrom; and upon vote being taken thereon, the vote in favor of was unanimous.

2022 FYE Annual Budget: Certificate as to Resolution and Adopting Vote: Kevin Askeland introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption: RESOLUTION 16-2022. RESOLUTION OF INTENTION OF THE SUN PRAIRIE VILLAGE COUNTY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, MONTANA TO MODIFY AND INCREASE RATES FOR THE USERS OF THE WATER SYSTEM AND SEWER SYSTEM; AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING THEREON.
