Roland Martin asked if there were any corrections to the Minutes of July 23rd, 2019, Regular Meeting of the Board. Kevin Askeland moved that the minutes be accepted as written, and Rick Matiska seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Roland Martin asked the Board if there were any questions regarding the financials: The compiled financial statements un-audited June 2019: No questions or comments. Restricted Fund Account Balance Report as of July 31st, 2019: Rick Matiska questioned the Sewer Fund Account for funds available for Wastewater Project, which can be used to assist in the construction costs, the unrestricted fund accounts could also be accessed if needed. Whereupon the motion for adoption of the foregoing resolution was seconded by Kevin Askeland; and upon vote being taken thereon, the vote in favor of was unanimous.

OLD BUSINESS:

Wastewater Planning Grant. Letter placed in file from United States Department of Agriculture regarding SPVCWSD Wastewater System Improvements Project PER Concurrence for a total project cost estimate of \$2,572,000.00. Rural Development did concur to the PER and recommend construction of Alternative LS3 to replace lift stations for \$400,000.00 and Alternative T1-1 hybrid lagoons (existing) plus nitrification reactor for \$1,976,800.00, with an increased estimate included in RD Apply of \$195,200.00 to account for inflation and AIS.

Water / Wastewater Jetting & Cleaning. Janet Fulmer stated Kois Brothers does have and is working on the District's sewer jetter; and still waiting for estimate from Straight Flush Drain Solutions. The Board advised to have jetting or cleaning done on problem area of Washington and Truman.

NEW BUSINESS:

2020 Fiscal Year Budget. Janet Fulmer advised the Board of time of year to start looking at the Budget for next year; and was going to make appointment with Dan Kramer of Montana Rural Water Systems to assist with a rate structure.
