## POLICY REGARDING INDEMNITY

This policy is applicable to the members of the Board of Directors, employees, and other agents of the Sun Prairie Village County Water and Sewer District.

Introduction: Members of the Board of Directors are required as a consequence of their position to make decisions and take such actions in the execution of their duties, which in their judgment are in the best interest of the District and the community of Sun Prairie Village, Cascade County, Montana. Likewise, in accordance with Section 7-13-2278, MCA, employees of the District make decisions and take actions daily which bind the Board of Directors and the District. Further, agents may be appointed from time to time by the District to assist in the performance of functions.

Policy Statement: The District's Board of Directors, employees, and agents deal with the public in administrative actions and in performing their principal duties of providing potable water and receiving and treating wastewaters. They may therefore be subject to certain claims, demands and liabilities.

It is the intent of this policy to provide that the District shall:

- (1) Establish by resolution that the Sun Prairie Village County Water and Sewer District shall save its Board of Directors, collectively or singularly, and its agents and employees from legal consequences of actions taken within the course and scope of their duties, whether such actions occur prior to or after the adoption of the indemnification resolution and policy.
- (2) This policy and resolution shall be construed in accordance with Sections 28-11-301, et seq., MCA, except that it shall be in the discretion of the Board of Directors as to whether in a particular case indemnification for misdemeanor offenses will be allowed.

The following is a resolution, duly passed by the Board of Directors of the Sun Prairie Village County Water and Sewer District, establishing this policy and enumerating the contractual agreement between itself and the Board of Directors, employees and agents.
